MOSCATO D'ASTI

Piedmont

Moscato D'Asti by Bona Massimo of Cuneo, Italy is a hand selected treasure with the highest government designation – DOCG. Made from the Moscato Canelli grape, the fermentation of this wine is arrested earlier than a Spumante. The product is then called "frizzante"; it is gentler and richer in natural sweetness and smoother in carbonation than that of Asti Spumante. In addition, by DOCG regulations, it is lower in alcohol. Our Moscato D'Asi has a natural balance of peach and apricot-sweetness with a cleansing surge of acidity.



Piedmont is a stronghold of tradition, renowned for wines from native varieties grown in vineyards that have been cultivated with devotion for centuries. The region's most admired wines are the aristocratic red Barolo and Barbaresco, both from the ancient Nebbiolo vine which is also the source of the northern Piedmontese reds of Gattinara, Ghemme and Carema. Dolcetto is appreciated as a rich, mellow red for every day.
